The victim stated that two days later, on Thursday, she got into another argument with the offender while drinking. The victim stated that the argument began in the hallway and the offender grabbed her by her hair and pulled her down the hallway. The victim stated that they got into the kitchen and the offender, again, began to shove her into things and knock her around. The victim stated that she was in the area of the living room and the offender, again, placed his hands around her neck and applied pressure making it difficult to breath. She stated the physical altercation then made its way into the bedroom while she attempted to get away from the male. She stated the offender continued to shove her down on the ground, and he then broke a wooden bedpost off the bed and began swinging it at her and threatening to beat her with it, but never actually hit her with it. The victim stated that she was able to get away from the male and laid down to sleep.

The victim stated that she and the offender have a two year old child together and that they have been in a serious relationship for three years. The victim stated that throughout both physical altercations, their child was in her bed and asleep approximately 90% of the time. She stated that when the child was awake, she was watching the altercation, but did not appear to understand what was happening.

The reporter spoke with the victim last night about a concerning Facebook post, but the victim stated she needed to sleep. The reporter stated he called the victim back this morning and she requested to go to the hospital, so he drove her here.

Crime Scene was called to the Hospital to photograph the victim's injuries. The victim was provided with a case number, and stated she needs to think about filing charges because she is concerned for her child's safety.
