Due to the exigent circumstances (the screams of the female gave me reason to believe that her or her child were in immediate danger) I opened the unlocked door and entered the home.</p> <p>I observed a male holding a two month old child (Juvenile 1) screaming at V1 while a female involved other (IO1) was seated on the couch with her 1 year old child (Juvenile 2). I asked the male multiple times to put Juvenile 1 down and he refused to do so. I attempted to guide the male out of the presence of V1 multiple times before he complied. The male was verbally aggressive and disobeyed my lawful orders multiple times. I was finally able to get the male to stand in the kitchen. I observed a silver and black handgun sitting on the counter within inches of the male. I attempted to move him away from the gun and he pushed back against me. I was able to move the male to the living room and secure the loaded firearm. At this point, I again gave the male commands to put the child down as a distraught V1 attempted to retrieve him from the male`s arms. My partner and I grabbed the male by each wrist and were able to forcibly remove his hands from the child as V1 picked him up. After the child was removed from the situation, the male struggled against my partner and I. The male tried to bring his arms forward in front of himself. During this process, a couch the male was leaning on slid forward and we held the male against the couch and wall. I secured the male in handcuffs and all use of force ceased. The male was holding the child specifically to keep me from being able to detain him.</p> <p>I then interviewed V1. V1 stated that the two month old child was the biological child of herself and the male offender. V1 stated that the male does not have custody and they are unmarried. V1 stated the male came to the home to pick up the child against her wishes. V1 stated the male arrived and was knocking loudly on the door. V1 stated she answered the door because she knew if she did not, he would kick the door down. V1 stated the male was very angry and kept asking her to come outside. V1 stated she feared what he would do to her if he got her alone. V1 stated she stood in the doorway to her sons room with her arms outstretched touching the doorframe on either side blocking the offenders entry.
