the put the child down, he knowingly and intentionally put the child in a situation that endangered its life and health. The male was holding the child specifically to keep me from being able to detain him.

I then interviewed V1. V1 stated that the two month old child was the biological child of herself and the male offender. V1 stated that the male does not have custody and they are unmarried. V1 stated the male came to the home to pick up the child against her wishes. V1 stated the male arrived and was knocking loudly on the door. V1 stated she answered the door because she knew if she did not, he would kick the door down. V1 stated the male was very angry and kept asking her to come outside. V1 stated she feared what he would do to her if he got her alone. V1 stated she stood in the doorway to her sons room with her arms outstretched touching the doorframe on either side blocking the offenders entry. V1 stated the offender grabbed the robe she was wearing by the collar and moved her from the doorway. V1 stated that in the process, the offender scratched her neck with his nails, drawing blood. IO1 and her one year old child were sitting in the same room approximately 5 feet away as this occurred awake and within earshot although IO1 stated she did not see the battery occur. I photographed V1's injury with my BodyWorn camera and tagged it with the associated case number.

A Sergeant was called to the scene for use of force. The offender was transported to the Vanderburgh County Correctional Center via the EPD Transport Wagon. The loaded silver and black handgun was taken as found property and deposited at EPD headquarters. The offender was given a case number to retrieve his handgun after his release. Victim 1 was provided a victim's rights form as well as a list of social services that may be of help to her and her child. Victim 1 was advised to apply for a protective order against the offender. A victim notification form was filled out to make Victim 1 aware of the offenders release.
