The female promptly fled the scene on foot. The male was secured in handcuffs and all use of force ceased.

I observed what appeared to be the development of a bruise on the male's right eye as well as several minor lacerations on either side of his neck that were not a result of Officer's use of force. I interviewed a witness who had observed the male and female prior to my arrival, as well as during our altercation. The witness stated the female had headbutted the male and was screaming at him. The male would not provide his statement as to how he developed his visible injuries. The male stated he had been living with the female for 2-3 days. My partner and I photographed the male's injuries and tagged them with the associated case number. The female was identified after she fled the scene.

I called for a Sergeant for the use of force. An EPD Sergeant arrived and interviewed the male as well as a witness to the altercation.
