One of the males involved stated he did not actually see a firearm, but did see the vehicle involved. When questioned about the make and model, the male stated it was a smaller SUV that was either gray or tan in color. The two males that allegedly witnessed the firearm stated that the male offender was a white male with a red hooded sweat shirt on. They both also stated that a blonde female driver and a brunette female passenger were in the suspected offenders vehicle when the incident occurred. Both also were unable to provide any description of the vehicle and a direction of travel post incident. Another male in the group stated he did not see the gun and could not recall a make and model on the vehicle. Due to the groups level of intoxication, and lack of cooperation, a detailed incident could not be established. The two males that stated they had actually seen the gun, became extremely uncooperative and were more focused on requesting a Sergeant to the scene. The two males became more focused on telling Officers how to do their jobs, instead of providing any more details about the incident. Officers then followed up with the establishment listed, due to one of the males saying a bouncer had witnessed the incident. Officers then made contact with security, who stated that the group of males had been talking about the incident, while inside the establishment, for over an hour, prior to approaching Officers. Upon the arrival of a Sergeant, Officers were finally able to obtain the names of the victims for this report, to which they were then provided a case number to follow up with any additional information.
