Famer asked Gomez to blow into a PBT. Gomez agreed. He achieved a reading of .158 BrAC. Due to the rain and language barrier I decided not to conduct SFSTs. I had Gomez read Implied Consent in Spanish. He agreed to submit to the chemical test. Gomez was transported to Deaconess Midtown to receive jail medical clearance paperwork.
