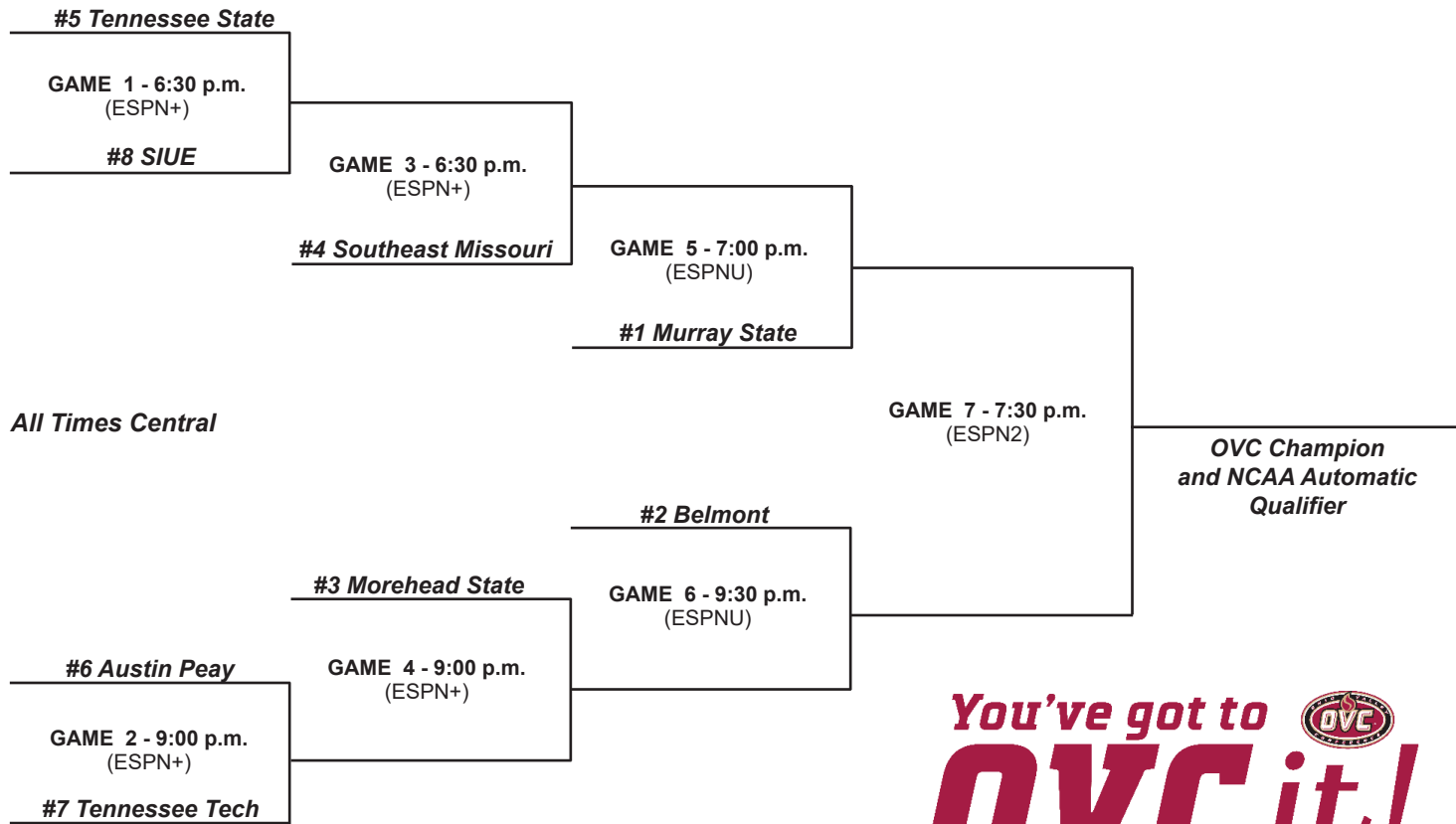

## **OVC TOURNAMENT TEAM SPECIFIC-NOTES**

### **GENERAL TOURNAMENT NOTES**

This marks the 59th overall OVC Men's Basketball Tournament; the event is the fourth-oldest Division I Championship nationally behind only the Southern, ACC and SEC... This marks the fifth-straight year the event has been held at the Ford Center in Evansville... The event will be held in the Ford Center through at least 2023... Three years ago the event set an all-time OVC Tournament attendance record during the semifinals (8,294) and broke that a night later in the championship game (10,525)... After a one-year change due to COVID scheduling (when the bracket was a traditional 1 vs. 8), the tournament has once again returned to a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds receiving double byes and the No. 3 and 4 seeds receiving single byes; it marks the 10th time that format has been used... The winner of this year's event will be the first nationally to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament... Last year Morehead State topped Belmont in the Final.

### **AUSTIN PEAY**

**All-Time Record:** 45-37

**Titles:** 5 (1987, 1996, 2003, 2008, 2016)

Austin Peay is in the OVC Tournament field for the fifth-straight season under first-year head coach Nate James... The team advanced to the Semifinals in each of the first three years the event was held at the Ford Center (2018-20)... ix years ago the Governors made history by becoming the first No. 8 seed to win the tournament; APSU won four games in four days (beating the No. 1, 2, 3 and 5 seeds along the way) to claim its fifth OVC crown... Austin Peay won its final two games and five of its final seven contests to qualify for the field... Freshman Elijah Hutchins-Everett leads the team in scoring (12.5/game), rebounding (6.8/game) and blocked shots (11)... Austin Peay will challenge Tennessee Tech in the First Round; the teams split the season series... Those two teams also met in the first round of the 2016 Tournament... APSU holds a 9-5 advantage over TTU in OVC Tournament games.

### **BELMONT**

**All-Time Record:** 12-6

**Titles:** 3 (2013, 2015, 2020)

Belmont has played in the last four OVC Tournament Title games, including a year ago when they lost to Morehead State... Two years ago they beat Murray State on the final play of the game... Belmont has been a top two seed in the event in each of the past seven seasons... If they would advance to play Murray State in the Finals, it would mark the sixth time they would have squared off for the championships (the other times were 2013, 2015, 2018, 2019, 2020)... Belmont is tied with Baylor for second nationally for the most victories since the start of the 2019-20 season (77)... Belmont has earned postseason invitations in 14 of the last 16 seasons, including nine berths to the NCAA Tournament... The Bruins have won 20 conference championships since 2006 -- third-most nationally over that span (Gonzaga, Kansas)... Belmont has won 20 or more games in 12 consecutive seasons (Gonzaga, Kansas, Oregon)... Point guard Grayson Murphy broke the OVC career assists record earlier this season and tied the career steals record in the last regular season game; entering the week Murphy ranks in the Top 10 nationally in both assists and steals.

### **MOREHEAD STATE**

**All-Time Record:** 36-45

**Titles:** 5 (1983, 1984, 2009, 2011, 2021)

A year ago Morehead State won three games (SEMO, Eastern Kentucky, Belmont) to win its fifth OVC Tournament Championship and first in a decade... This year the team is back in the field for the fourth-straight season, this time as the No. 3 seed where they earn a single-bye to the quarterfinals... The Eagles have won at least one game in 10 of its last 12 appearances (only failing to do so in 2017 and 2020)... MSU went undefeated at home during the 2021 calendar year and had a 20-game home winning streak until it was snapped on January 29... The program has reached 20 overall wins for the second-straight season and the ninth time since 1929-30... Second-year forward Johni Broome, last year's OVC Freshman of the Year, ranks in the Top 10 nationally in double-doubles (22 - 3rd), blocks (3.97/game - 4th) and rebounding (10.6/game - 9th)... Morehead State will play the winner of the Austin Peay/Tennessee Tech game; MSU swept both of those teams this year... The Eagles hold a 4-3 advantage in OVC Tournament games against Austin Peay and an 8-3 advantage against Tennessee Tech.

### **MURRAY STATE**

**All-Time Record:** 72-39

**Titles:** 17 (1951, 1964, 1988, 1990, 1991, 1992, 1995, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2002, 2004, 2006, 2010, 2012, 2018, 2019)

Murray State claimed its 28th OVC regular season championship this season, finishing 18-0 in league play, making them one of six teams to ever go undefeated in Conference action (and first since 2014-15)... Murray State won the OVC Tournament crown in each of the first two years in Evansville (2018, 2019) and lost in the title game two years ago... The program's 17 all-time titles are an OVC record... Entering the week the team's 28 overall wins are the most nationally,

and its 18-game winning streak is tied with South Dakota State for the longest nationally... The Racers are ranked in both the AP and Coaches Top 25 polls; they are the first OVC team to be ranked since March 2015... Fourth-year guard Tevin Brown became the OVC all-time leader in 3-pointers made earlier this season... The Racers earned the No. 1 seed and will get a double bye to the semifinals.

### **SOUTHEAST MISSOURI**

**All-Time Record:** 11-15

**Titles:** 1 (2000)

Southeast Missouri is back in the OVC Tournament field for the second-straight season under second year head coach Brad Korn... The Redhawks earned the No. 4 seed and will receive a bye to the quarterfinals where they will face either Tennessee State or SIUE... The No. 4 seed is the highest for the program since 2000, a year they were the No. 2 seed and won their lone OVC Tournament Championship... SEMO also played in the OVC Tournament Title game in 1999 (both of those appearances were against Murray State)... The Redhawks won two of its final three regular season games, with its lone loss coming by two points to No. 19 ranked Murray State... SEMO will play the winner of the Tennessee State/SIUE game; the Redhawks swept SIUE and split with TSU this season... SEMO has never played SIUE in the OVC Tournament and are 1-0 all-time against Tennessee State.

### **SIUE**

**All-Time Record:** 0-5

**Titles:** 0

SIUE is in the field for the second year in row and sixth overall time... This marks the fifth time they have been the No. 8 seed... They are still looking for their first victory in the event... Overall the Cougars have been in the tournament in four of the five years it has been at the Ford Center... SIUE recorded 11 total wins this year, the second-most of its Division I era (12 in 2014-15 is the most)... The Cougars won two of their final three games to make this year's field, including topping Morehead State on the final day of the regular season... SIUE will open play with Tennessee State on Wednesday; TSU won the season series 2-0... The two teams have not played each other in the OVC Tournament.

### **TENNESSEE STATE**

**All-Time Record:** 13-27

**Titles:** 2 (1993, 1994)

After missing out on the tournament a year ago, the Tigers return to Evansville this season as the No. 5 seed... Two years ago the Tigers topped Morehead State in overtime in the first round of the event, which snapped a three-game tournament skid for the program... The Tigers played in the OVC Tournament Championship game in 2012 (falling to Murray State)... TSU is looking for its first tournament crown since the second of back-to-back titles in 1994... Tennessee State has won three of its last four games... Graduate student Kassim Nicholson has 11 double-doubles this season, a mark that is second in the OVC... TSU opens play against No. 8 seed SIUE; the Big Blue swept the season series (2-0)... The two teams have never played in the OVC Tournament.

### **TENNESSEE TECH**

**All-Time Record:** 25-44

**Titles:** 1 (1967)

Tennessee Tech is back in the OVC Tournament field for the first time since 2018 and first time under head coach John Pelphey... The Golden Eagles are in search of its first OVC Tournament title since 1967, when the tournament was held at the beginning of the season and did not include an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament... Tech was in the OVC Tournament Championship game in 2011, falling to Morehead State; the team was also tournament runners-up in 2002 and 2003... Tennessee Tech won five of its last seven OVC games to qualify for the Tournament... Fourth-year guard Jr. Clay is the only Golden Eagle to rank in the top-10 in scoring, assists, steals, and 3-point field goals made for their career... TTU will challenge in-state foe Austin Peay in the First Round; the teams split the season series... Those two teams also met in the first round of the 2016 Tournament, the year the No. 8 seeded Govs won four games in four days to claim the OVC Title.

## THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### PLAYER

#### KJ Williams, F • 6-10, 245, Jr. • Cleveland, Miss. • Murray State

Williams capped the regular season by averaging 26.5 points, 6.5 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.0 steals/game while hitting 55 percent (22-of-40) from the field, 50 percent (5-of-10) from 3-point range and 100 percent (4-of-4) from the free throw line. His play helped Murray State win a pair of games and finish OVC play 18-0 to capture the program's 28th OVC regular season championship. Williams hit the 30-point plateau for the third time this season with 30 points on 12-of-19 shooting (4-of-4 3-pointers) in a 76-43 win over Belmont on Thursday. He played 32 minutes and added five rebounds and a steal. On Saturday, he had 23 points, eight rebounds, two assists, a block and steal in a come-from-behind win at Southeast Missouri. In that game Williams was 10-of-21 from the field. This marks the fifth Player of the Week award of the year for Williams who ranks first in the OVC in scoring (18.2 points/game), second in rebounding (8.5/game) and fifth in field goal percentage (54.4%).

### CO-NEWCOMER

#### Caleb Stone-Carrawell, G • 6-7, 215, Second Year • Concord, N.C. • Austin Peay

Stone-Carrawell, a transfer from Charlotte, averaged 17.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists/game while hitting 61.1 percent (11-of-18) from the field and 90.9 percent (10-of-11) from the free throw line in a pair of road victories. On Thursday at SIUE, he scored a career-high 24 points in a career-high 36 minutes to help APSU defeat the Cougars 68-64 in overtime. Stone-Carrawell was 8-of-13 from the field against SIUE while shooting 3-of-7 from behind the 3-point line. The guard was 5-of-6 from the charity stripe against SIUE to go along with three rebounds and a career-high six assists. In the regular-season finale at Eastern Illinois, Stone-Carrawell led the Govs with 13 points on 3-of-5 shooting from the field and a perfect 5-for-5 clip from the free-throw line.

### CO-NEWCOMER

#### Kassim Nicholson, F • 6-7, Grad. • Jackson, Miss. • Tennessee State

In two road games Nicholson averaged 16.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, 2.0 steals and 1.5 assists/game while hitting 59.1 percent (13-of-22) from the field and 80 percent (4-of-5) from the free throw line. The transfer from UAB had 15 points, five rebounds, three assists, three steals and a block in road win over Tennessee Tech to open the week. Hit 6-of-9 shots and 2-of-2 free throws in the win. He closed the regular season with his 11th double-double of the season (second-most in the OVC) against Belmont. He had 17 points, 11 rebounds and a steal while hitting 7-of-13 field goals in that game.

### FRESHMAN

#### Elijah Hutchins-Everett, C • 6-11, 270, Fr. • Orange, N.J. • Austin Peay

Everett earned his fifth OVC Freshman of the Week award after averaging 11.5 points, 10.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists, 1.0 steals and 1.0 blocks game in a pair of wins. The center hit 52.6 percent (10-of-19) from the field as the Govs won twice to secure the No. 6 seed for the OVC Tournament. In a 68-64 overtime victory at SIUE on Thursday, Hutchins-Everett had 10 points and 10 rebounds on 5-of-11 shooting from the field. Against the Cougars, he recorded two assists, two steals and four offensive rebounds. In the regular season finale on Saturday, Hutchins-Everett posted his second straight double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds on 5-of-8 shooting from the field. Again the freshman had four offensive rebounds to go along with one assist and two blocks. He finished the regular season with six double-doubles, the fifth-most in the OVC. Hutchins-Everett ranks fifth in the OVC in rebounding (6.8/game) and ninth in field goal percentage (51.6%).

## NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

**OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights:** As of Monday, two OVC teams were in the Top 70 of the NET: Murray State (24) and Belmont (60) ... If the OVC would place two teams in the NCAA Tournament this year, it would mark the second time in the last three NCAA Tournaments that would have happened (Belmont and Murray State both made it in 2019) ... Murray State won its 28th OVC Championship and is the No. 1 seed for the OVC Tournament ... The Racers became just the sixth OVC team to go undefeated in league play, finishing 18-0; MSU and South Dakota State are the only two teams nationally undefeated in Conference action this year ... Murray State and South Dakota State are tied for first nationally with 18-game winning streaks ... MSU's 28 overall wins are the most nationally ... Murray State is now ranked No. 22 in both the Associated Press and Coaches Top 25 polls; this year marks the first time an OVC team has been ranked since 2015 (Murray State) and first time a team has been ranked for more than one week since 2012 (Murray State was ranked in the final 14 polls that year) ... Murray State's Tevin Brown established a new OVC record for career made 3-pointers on January 29; he now has 342 makes (eighth among active Division I players) ... Over the past 30 years Brown is the only Division I player to tally at least 340 3-pointers, 600 rebounds, 390 assists, and 60 blocks in their career ... Belmont's Grayson Murphy broke the OVC career assists record (699) on January 24 at Eastern Illinois; Murphy now has 769 career assists ... On February 26, Murphy tied the OVC career steals record of 279 also held by Tennessee Tech's Van Usher ... Murphy recorded the 22nd triple-double in OVC history on January 17 at SIUE; he had 11 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists, marking his second triple-double in as many seasons ... As of February 27, Murphy ranks 10th nationally in assists (5.9/game) and 7th in steals (2.42/game) ... Morehead State's Johni Broome has had six blocks in a game 10 times this season; he ranks third nationally in blocks/game 3.97/game) ... Broome now has 123 blocks on the season, tied for the third-most in OVC single-season history (15 off the record) ... Broome had 12 blocks on February 16 at UT Martin; the 12 blocks tied the MSU single-game record, was one off the OVC record and are tied for the most by a Division I player this season (with Auburn's Walker Kessler) ... Broome also ranks third nationally in double-doubles (22) and 9th nationally in rebounding (10.6/game) ... Broome is just the second player in MSU history with 20-plus double-doubles in a single-season (joining record-holder Kenneth Faried's 28 in 2010-11) ... Southeast Missouri redshirt freshman Phillip Russell had 35 points, 10 rebounds, five steals and four assists on February 7 at SIUE; he is only the second Division I freshman in the past 25 years to have 35-plus points, 10-plus rebounds and five-plus steals in a game ... The OVC has had as many as eight (8) former players on active NBA rosters this season; currently five players are on rosters.

**2022 All-OVC Teams and Awards Announced on Tuesday:** The announcement of the 2022 All-OVC Basketball Teams with the Player of the Year, Defensive Player of the Year, Freshman of the Year and Coach of the Year awards will be announced on Tuesday, March 1. The announcement will come first on Twitter (@OVCSports) between Noon and 1 p.m. CT.

**OVC Basketball Championships Set For Ford Center in Evansville For Fifth Consecutive Year:** The OVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championships presented by TicketSmarter will be held March 2-5 at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana. It marks the fifth-straight season the event will be held in the building. The Ford Center, which opened in 2011, is an 11,000-seat arena located in the core of Evansville's downtown district. The 290,000-square foot facility serves as home of the University of Evansville's men's basketball team and the Evansville Thunderbolts of the Southern Professional Hockey League. The Ford Center also serves as host to numerous sporting events and concerts on an annual basis. In September 2019 it was announced the tournament would remain at the Ford Center at least through the 2023 Championship with an option for 2024. The 2019 Championships saw record-breaking attendance at the venue, as the men's semifinals drew an OVC neutral site record 8,294 fans, a mark that was broken the next night with an attendance of 10,525.

**Murray State Claims OVC Championship:** Murray State won the 2021-22 OVC Regular Season Championship. This marks the fourth time in the last five years and the 28th overall title for the Racers. MSU has now won crowns in 1951, 1964, 1968, 1969, 1980, 1982, 1983, 1988, 1989, 1990, 1991, 1992, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000, 2006, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2015, 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022.

**Undefeated Conference Seasons:** Murray State finished the year 18-0 in Conference action, making them only the sixth team in OVC history to go undefeated in league play. They join Western Kentucky teams in 1949-50 (8-0), 1965-66 (14-0) and 1969-70 (14-0), the 2003-04 Austin Peay team (16-0) and the 2014-15 Murray State team (16-0).

**Teams Undefeated in Conference Play; Overall Win Streaks:** As of February 28, Murray State was one of two teams nationally to be undefeated in Conference play. They are joined South Dakota State. The Racers and Jackrabbits have each won 18-straight games, tied for first nationally.

**Racers Tie OVC Record For Most Conference Wins in a Season:** Murray State's 18 OVC victories tied the record for most in a season, joining the 2020-21 Belmont team that also won 18 games (going 18-2 in a 20-game schedule).

**Murray State Ranked in Top 25 Polls:** Murray State is now ranked No. 22 in both the Associated Press and Coaches Top 25 poll. The Racers fell three spots in the AP poll and one spot in the Coaches poll despite going 2-0 last week. On February 7, MSU became the first OVC team to be ranked since the Racers were No. 25 on March 2, 2015. Additionally, they are the first OVC team to be ranked in multiple consecutive weeks since Murray State was ranked in the final 14 polls of the 2012 season.

**Murphy Sets OVC Assist Record:** On January 24 at Eastern Illinois, Belmont graduate student guard **Grayson Murphy** established a new OVC career assists record, breaking the former mark of 699 by Eastern Kentucky's Bryce Jones (1977-81). Murphy now has 769 career assists, which ranks second nationally among active players.

**Murphy Ties OVC Steals Record:** On February 26 against Tennessee State, Belmont graduate student guard **Grayson Murphy** tied the OVC career steals record of 279 by Tennessee Tech's Van Usher (1989-92).

**Brown Sets OVC 3-Pointers Made Record:** On January 29 against Morehead State, fourth year guard **Tevin Brown** established a new OVC record for career 3-pointers made, breaking the old mark of 319 by Austin Peay's Joe Sibbitt (1994-98). Brown now has 342 made 3-pointers.

**All-Around Brown:** Over the past 30 years, fourth-year Murray State guard **Tevin Brown** is the only Division I player to record at least at least 340 made 3-pointers, 600 rebounds, 390 assists and 60 blocks in their career.

**Home Court Winning Streaks:** As of February 28, Murray State has won 16-straight home games, the ninth-longest streak nationally. Gonzaga has the nation's longest home court winning streak (67). Morehead State had the third-longest home court winning streak (20), but it was ended by Murray State on

The 2022 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Championships presented by TicketSmarter will be held March 2-5 at the Ford Center in Evansville, Indiana.

It marks the fifth-straight year the event has been held at the Ford Center. The Ford Center, which opened in 2011, is an 11,000-seat arena located in the core of Evansville's downtown district. The 290,000-square foot facility serves as home of the University of Evansville's men's basketball team and the Evansville Thunderbolts of the Southern Professional Hockey League.

The tournament features eight men's and eight women's teams vying for that automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

The merit-based bracket gives double byes to the semifinals for the No. 1 and No. 2 seeds and single byes to the quarterfinals for the No. 3 and 4 seeds. The first round features No. 5 vs. No. 8 and No. 6 vs. No. 7.

The first round games can be seen on ESPN+. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 4 and televised on ESPN+. The men's championship game is on Saturday, March 5 and televised live on ESPN2.

All seven games of the women's tournament can be seen on ESPN+.

**Triple-Doubles:** Belmont graduate guard **Grayson Murphy** recorded the 22nd triple-double in OVC history on January 17 when he had 11 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists in an 80-64 win at SIUE. It was the first triple-double in the OVC since Murphy accomplished the feat on February 13, 2021. As of February 14, he is one of 17 Division I players with a triple-double in 2021-22.

**CollegelInsider.com Mid-Major Poll:** In the latest (Feb. 21) CollegelInsider.com Mid-Major Poll, Murray State was ranked No. 2, Belmont was ranked No. 8 and Morehead State was receiving votes. Now in its 23rd season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of teams from the following conferences: America East, ASUN, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, WAC and West Coast.

**Recent Postseason Success:** With only one team in the postseason in 2021, the OVC saw a streak of at least one win in 11-straight postseasons come to an end. It had been the longest stretch in league history. Morehead State won a NCAA game in 2009, Murray State won in the NCAA Tournament in 2010, Morehead State won in the NCAA's in 2011, Murray State won in the NCAA's in 2012, Eastern Kentucky won in the CIT in 2013, Belmont (NIT) and Murray State (CIT) won games in 2014, Eastern Illinois (CIT), Eastern Kentucky (CIT), Murray State (NIT) and UT Martin (CIT) scored victories in 2015 (the four different teams to record a victory in the single postseason was an OVC record), Morehead State (CBI) and UT Martin (CIT) won in 2016, Belmont (NIT) and UT Martin (CIT) scored wins in 2017, Austin Peay (CIT) and Jacksonville State (CBI) won in 2018 and Belmont and Murray State in 2019 (NCAA) before no postseason was held in 2020.

**Postponements:** This season when games were postponed due to health and safety protocols, OVC teams were allowed to reschedule up to four of those contests. The rescheduled games took place on Monday's during a six-week period between January 17 and February 14. If a team has reached the four-game limit, any other games will be postponed and could potentially be made up if a window opens on a Thursday/Saturday due to other postponements. If a game cannot be rescheduled, it will be declared a no-contest. As of February 21, there were 14 OVC men's games postponed; of those 14 games, 13 have been made-up with only the Tennessee Tech at Southeast Missouri game originally scheduled for January 13 being declared a no-contest.

**Smith Named to CoSIDA Academic All-District Team:** Belmont's **Luke Smith** has been named to the 2021-22 CoSIDA Academic All-District® Division I Men's Basketball Team by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Smith, who earned Academic All-America honors last season, earned his bachelor's degree in business administration this past May with 3.67 grade-point average and holds a 3.92 GPA in the Belmont MBA program. First-team Academic All-District® honorees advance to the CoSIDA Academic All-America® Team ballot, with first-, second- and third-team Academic All-America honorees to be announced in late May.

**Williams Named National Player of the Week (Feb. 14):** Murray State junior forward **KJ Williams** was named the Oscar Robertson National Player of the Week by the USBWA and the Lou Henson National Player of the Week by CollegelInsider.com on February 14 after his play in a pair of road wins where he averaged 30.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 1.5 blocks/game and hitting 63.9 percent (23-of-36) from the field and 85.7 percent (12-of-14) from the free throw line. At Tennessee State, the Racers trailed by seven points at halftime but Williams scored 31 of his career-high 39 points after halftime as MSU won 72-62. The junior hit 15-of-22 shots (68.2%), had six rebounds, two blocks and a steal (and zero turnovers) in 38 minutes of action. Two days later at Morehead State he recorded his 10th double-double of the season with 21 points and 12 rebounds in a come-from-behind win at Morehead State. In that game MSU trailed by nine points with 5:17 to play but ended the game on a 17-4 run to win 57-53. His bucket with 1:56 to play gave the Racers its first lead since early in the second half, and he added another field goal, two free throws a steal and rebound in the final minute of the game.

**OVC Players in the NBA:** Four former OVC players were on NBA rosters to begin the 2021-22 season; the four players ranked the OVC 12th among all Division I conferences. In December, two-time OVC Player of the Year Terry Taylor signed a two-way contract with the Indiana Pacers, making it five OVC players on rosters. In late December two additional former OVC players signed 10-Day contracts, making it seven former OVC players in the NBA and an eighth player made a roster when two-year Eastern Illinois player Alfonzo McKinnie signed with the Chicago Bulls (but he has since been released). As of February 20, there are five players on active rosters (Shaq Buchanan is currently not on the Grizzlies active roster and Xavier Moon is currently not on the Clippers roster). Included in the total is former Murray State All-American Ja Morant, the No. 2 pick in the 2019 NBA Draft. Morant, an NBA All-Star this season, would go on to become the first OVC player to be named the 2019-20 NBA Rookie of the Year after averaging 17.8 points, 7.3 assists, 3.9 rebounds and 0.9 steals per game in 67 contests. Dating back to 1983-84, he is one of just three players to attend a non-Power 5 college to win the award, joining Damian Lillard of Weber State (2012-13) and Larry Johnson of UNLV (1991-92). Another former Racer, Cameron Payne, helped Phoenix advance to the NBA Finals a year ago. It marked the fourth time in the past six years an OVC player had competed in the NBA Finals; Payne was the third all-time Murray State player to accomplish the feat. **Matchup of Undefeated Teams:** The January 29 matchup of Morehead State (8-0) at Murray State (9-0) marked only the third time in the past 18 years (2003-04 to present) that OVC teams undefeated in league play (with at least five games played) have squared off.

- January 29, 2022: Murray State (9-0), Morehead State (8-0)
- January 24, 2016: Belmont (6-0), Tennessee State (5-0)
- January 19, 2013: Belmont (5-0), Tennessee State (6-0)

**OVC to Produce 10-Game Linear Television Package:** The OVC will produce a national television package in 2021-22 that will include nine men's basketball games and one women's basketball contest that will air on the ESPN Family of Networks. Five of the seven regular season games will air on ESPNU, as will the OVC Men's Tournament semifinals, with two games airing on ESPNNews. The Men's Championship game will air on ESPN2.

**Wins in 2021 Calendar Year:** During the 2021 calendar year, Morehead State ranked seventh nationally with 28 total wins, while Belmont was eighth with 27 total wins. Gonzaga was the national leader in wins in 2021 (33).

**Muszynski on Preseason Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Watch List:** Belmont graduate student **Nick Muszynski** was named to the 2022 Kareem Abdul-Jabbar Center of the Year Award Watch List by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame. Named after Class of 1995 Hall of Famer and three-time NCAA Champion Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, the annual honor in its eighth year recognizes the top centers in men's college basketball. A national committee of top college basketball personnel determined the watch list of 20 candidates. He was not on the updated list of 10 announced in late January.

**Four OVC Players on Lou Henson Award Watch List:** Four OVC players have been named to the Lou Henson Award Midseason Watch List by CollegeInsider.com. The four players were Morehead State forward **Johi Broome**, Murray State guard **Tevin Brown**, Belmont guard **Grayson Murphy** and Belmont center **Nick Muszynski**. The award, which is presented annually to the top mid-major player in division I college basketball, honors the former Illinois and New Mexico State head coach who won 775 games in 41 seasons. The award will be given out in April.

**Little Rock to Join OVC in 2022-23:** The University of Arkansas at Little Rock will join the OVC on July 1, 2022, making it only the 22nd full-time member in the 74-year history of the league. The announcement was made at a December 9 press conference in Little Rock. Since making the jump to Division I, Little Rock's athletic programs have combined for 50 conference championships, including a combined 21 for men's and women's basketball, with 40 NCAA postseason appearances by Trojan athletic programs.

**USI to Join the OVC in 2022-23:** The University of Southern Indiana (USI) will join the OVC on July 1, 2022, making it only the 23rd full-time member in the 74-year history of the league. The announcement was made on February 9 on its campus in Evansville, Indiana. USI, which currently competes at the NCAA Division II level, will begin its reclassification process to the NCAA Division I level during the 2022-23 academic year, when they will be included in OVC regular season schedules and be eligible to compete in OVC Championships. USI will be eligible to earn automatic bids to NCAA Championships beginning in 2026-27, its first full season of full Division I membership. USI's athletic programs have combined for 188 NCAA Tournament appearances, including winning National Championships in baseball (2010, 2014), men's basketball (1995) and softball (2018).

**Lindenwood to Join the OVC in 2022-23:** Lindenwood University will join the OVC on July 1, 2022, making it only the 24th full-time member in the 74-year history of the league. The announcement was made on February 23 on its campus in St. Charles, Missouri. Lindenwood, which currently competes at the NCAA Division II level, will begin its reclassification process to the NCAA Division I level during the 2022-23 academic year, when they will be included in OVC regular season schedules and be eligible to compete in OVC Championships. LU will be eligible to earn automatic bids to NCAA Championships beginning in 2026-27, its first full season of full Division I membership. Since joining the NCAA, Lindenwood has won four National Championships and in 2017, ranked sixth in the NCAA Directors' Cup, which included five team conference titles. In the NCAA era, Lindenwood has claimed three regional championships, 31 conference titles (including football titles in 2019 and 2021), and eight conference tournament championships.

**Broome and Murphy Tabbed as Preseason Co-Players of the Year:** The 2021-22 OVC Preseason Men's Basketball Team is headlined by Co-Players of the Year, Morehead State second-year forward **Johi Broome** and Belmont graduate student guard **Grayson Murphy**. Murphy is the fourth Belmont player to pick up the award (joining Craig Bradshaw, Evan Bradds and Dylan Windler) while Broome is the first Morehead State player to earn the honor since Kenneth Faried was tabbed with the honor in 2009-10 and 2010-11. Overall, five different schools were represented on the team with Belmont leading the way with three selections, Morehead State and Murray State having two picks apiece and Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech having one pick apiece. Six of the 10 picks earned All-OVC first or second-team honors last year. Other returning first-team All-OVC selections from 2020-21 include Murray State redshirt junior guard **Tevin Brown** redshirt junior forward **KJ Williams** and Belmont senior center **Nick Muszynski** while Tennessee Tech redshirt junior guard **Jr. Clay** was a returning second-team pick. Additionally, Tennessee State senior guard **Carlos Marshall Jr.** earned second-team All-OVC honors in 2019-20, but missed all last year due to injury. The team was rounded out by Southeast Missouri redshirt junior guard **Chris Harris**, Morehead State redshirt junior guard **Skyelar Potter** and Belmont senior guard **Luke Smith**.

**Belmont Picked as OVC Preseason Favorites:** In a vote of OVC head men's basketball coaches and communication directors, Belmont has been picked the preseason favorites for the 2021-22 season. It marks the fifth time in the past six seasons the Bruins have been tabbed preseason favorites. Belmont picked up 17 of a possible 20 first-place votes to tally 161 total points in being picked first. Morehead State picked up the other three first-place votes and 141 points in being ranked second, just ahead of Murray State (136 points). Southeast Missouri was tabbed fourth (101) and followed by Tennessee State (84), Austin Peay (76), SIUE (65), Tennessee Tech (62), Eastern Illinois (43) and UT Martin (34).

**The 2021-22 Season:** The 2021-22 season marks the 74th of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 73 years, 13 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship.

**ESPN+:** This year marks the fourth of the OVC's media rights deal with ESPN to air games on ESPN+, the multi-sport, direct-to-consumer video service from The Walt Disney Company Direct-to-Consumer & International segment. This season over 200 men's and women's basketball regular season Conference games and non-conference games will be streamed on ESPN+. **OVC NOTABLES**

- The OVC placed two teams in the NCAA Tournament in 2019, with Murray State earning the automatic bid and Belmont earning an at-large berth. It marked the first time since 1987 the league had placed two teams in the field (Austin Peay/Middle Tennessee).
- In 2019 both Belmont (Temple in the First Round) and Murray State (Marquette in the First Round) won games marking the first time since 1971 (when Western Kentucky went to the Final Four) that OVC teams had won two games in the NCAA Tournament in the same season.
- Between 2009 and 2019, OVC teams won at least one postseason game for 11-straight postseasons. The included four-straight years (2009-12) with NCAA Tournament wins.
- Since 2018, the OVC Basketball Tournament has been held annually at the state-of-the-art Ford Center in Evansville. The 2019 Championships saw record-breaking attendance at the venue, as the men's semifinals drew an OVC neutral site record 8,294 fans, a mark that was broken the next night with an attendance of 10,525.
- Four (4) former OVC players were on NBA rosters to begin the season. That ranked 12th among all Division I Conferences. The players are Robert Covington (Tennessee State), Ja Morant (Murray State), Cameron Payne (Murray State) and Dylan Windler (Belmont).
- Cameron Payne helped lead the Suns to the NBA Finals in 2021; it marked the fourth time in the past six years an OVC player had competed in the NBA Finals
- In 2019 both Ja Morant (No. 2 overall) and Dylan Windler (No. 26 overall) were selected in the First Round of the NBA Draft. It marked just the second time that two OVC players have been selected in the First Round of the same NBA Draft and first since 1954 when Western Kentucky's Tom Marshall and Jack Turner were selected with the seventh and eighth picks of the First Round. The duo were the 10th and 11th former OVC players selected in the First Round (Morant was tied for the highest). Morant would go on to win the 2019-20 NBA Rookie of the Year Award, making him one of three players from non-Power 5 leagues to win the award since 1983-84.
- Over the previous 74 years, 13 different teams have claimed at least one OVC regular season championship.
