At this time I went to talk to the Republic Services supervisor (IO) about what had occurred.</p> <p>IO told me that he got a call from trash truck 2050 (recycling pickup) that an unknown male was following/harassing them in alley's as they were making their normal stops picking up recycling items. IO then responded and made contact with victim. The victim initially told IO that he was upset that a trash truck swerved at him. Victim then changed his story to the trash truck "hit" him. IO stated that the victim then called dispatch again demanded police. IO took a few steps away from the victim and waited for police arrival.
