Gildersleeve stated this was his second call to police today, as he had already made a police report regarding his apartment being burglarized last evening. He stated after he made the first report he later went to his vehicle and found it to be damaged and some of the items within the vehicle to be taken. Gildersleeve relayed he found damage to the exterior and interior of his vehicle. He stated there was damage to the left and right, front fender areas, damage to his dash within his vehicle, and a cigarette burn to one of the seats. He reported after observing the damage he then found some of his belongings to be gone. He stated he was missing miscellaneous items including fishing tackle and clothes, but also found a laptop, an emergency battery, and tools to be missing from his vehicle.

Gildersleeve was adamant that he locks his vehicle and was not sure how the offender would have gained entry to his vehicle. At the time of the incident, Gildersleeve stated his vehicle was parked in the back parking lot of his apartment complex that is reserved for residents and visitors. He reported there is an outside security camera that sits to the top left of the apartment building's back entrance, but he does not believe this camera would have captured the area in which his vehicle was parked.

Gildersleeve believes the same offender that burglarized his apartment is the same person responsible for damaging his vehicle and taking items from his vehicle.

Gildersleeve was provided with a case number. I suggested he check with his apartment complex to see if their security system would have captured the incident involving his vehicle.

I, Ofc. N. Pitt, was on routine patrol in my fully marked Evansville Police Department vehicle. While in the area of Florida St. and Fifth Ave., I observed the listed vehicle operating with no license plate. I initiated a traffic stop in front of 1315 W. Eichel Ave.

As I approached the vehicle, I immediately noticed the smell of raw marijuana emitting from the vehicle. I had the driver, Jamie, step out of the vehicle and asked if there was any marijuana in the vehicle. Jamie stated she was unaware of any marijuana in the vehicle. I then had the passenger, Andrew, step out of the vehicle. I asked Andrew if he had any marijuana on him. Andrew stated he had marijuana in his coat pocket. I then conducted a search incident to arrest of Andrew's person. I located a baggy containing a green leafy substance in Andrew's coat pocket. Based on my training and experience, I immediately recognized the substance as marijuana. The substance was tested with a NARK II 2005 - Duqueois Levine Reagent Test Kit. The substance tested positive for THC and had a field weight of 9 grams.

She stated she contacted NetSpend customer service who informed her \$6000.00, all of her income tax return amount, had been used through various transactions over the past two days. Reed was able to obtain an itemized list of some of those unauthorized transactions, which included a transaction at The Right Stuff on 3/11/22 for the amount of \$37.43. Reed stated she went to The Right Stuff and was able to view security camera footage of the unauthorized transaction. She recognized the subject using her card as the offender. She stated the offender was a white male wearing black shoes, jeans, white hooded sweatshirt, and a red shirt underneath the hooded sweatshirt. The offender had a gray backpack which Reed stated was her daughter's backpack she had given to the offender. Reed stated she filed a claim through NetSpend for the unauthorized use of her funds. Reed was provided with a case number. She was asked to contact The Right Stuff to obtain the video evidence of the offender using her card for the unauthorized transaction.
