Byard stated the offender is a past acquaintance with whom he has not spoken to for approximately one year. He relayed his last encounter with the offender was during an incident where, per Byard, the offender was intoxicated and assaulted two people at a party. Byard relayed during that incident he intervened to stop the offender from harming those two individuals.

Byard reported he received several messages from the offender this afternoon via Facebook Messenger. He stated one of the messages read, "Just want to let you know I haven't forgotten when I see you," and another message read, "I'll see you soon...I'll do to you what you did to me." Byard relayed he was not sure why the offender would be contacting him after a year's period of time.

Byard stated he was fearful the offender would cause him physical harm. When asked, Byard stated the offender did not know where he lived, but stated the offender has "people all over" that would know how to locate Byard.

Byard was provided with a case number. I recommended he block the offender from all social media accounts and block his number if he received any phone correspondence from the offender. I also suggested he not respond back to the offender. He was instructed on how to follow-up with charges through the Prosecutor's Office.

Officers provided both parties with a document that had a case number and detailed the rights of victims of domestic violence. They were also provided with contact information for services available to victims of domestic violence. Officers offered to provide transportation to those services. Additionally, the male and the female were provided with information regarding acquiring a protective order. Officers advised the parties to separate, and the female stated she was going to leave the residence. She departed the area prior to officer's leaving.
