She relayed the email stated the camera was charged to the payment method listed on her Amazon Account for the amount of \$1,099.00. The email went on to say if this was not her order or needed a refund/exchange she could contact a phone number which was listed at the bottom of the email. Austin reported she contacted the phone number at the bottom of the email and was connected to who she though to be an Amazon representative (offender). She stated the representative was male. She was informed by the offender that she would be able to be reimbursed for the amount charged for the camera by going to Target and purchasing three, \$500.00 gift cards. She was told once the gift cards were purchased she would need to provide the gift card access numbers to the offender and she would then be reimbursed for the camera and the cards within 10 minutes. Austin stated the offender stayed on the phone for her while she purchased the gift cards. She reported the call was disconnected at one point and she was called back by another male. She relayed she purchased the gift cards, provided the gift card access codes to the offenders, but she was never reimbursed for the gift cards. She stated she did not see where an actual amount of \$1,099.00 for the camera was deducted from her bank account. She did relay that during the phone conversation she gave permission for the offenders to "remote" into her cell phone. She stated she was in the process of contacting her bank and credit card companies. Austin stated she contacted Target about this issue and she was provided with a case number for their investigation. She relayed she saved the original email she received and the gift card receipts. Glover described the suspect's vehicle as a four door sedan, dark gray or Atlantic Blue in color. She was not able to obtain a license plate number, but believed the license plate to be from Kentucky. She described the suspect driver to be a white female, approximately 5`1, and weighing about 100lbs. She was about 20 to 30 years of age and had long, dark blonde hair. Glover was not able to provide any information regarding the suspect's clothing. The suspect was with a mixed race male who was approximately 5`8 to 5`10, 190lbs, and between 20 and 30 years of age. The couple also had a small child with them. Glover reported the suspect left the parking lot and traveled north toward Lynch Rd.

Glover was able to provide some identifying information regarding the suspect based upon entry waivers each family must sign before participating in activities at the business. She stated the business does have a security camera system, but stated only the owners of the business had access to the system.

I spoke to the reporter and the victim, Diekmann, by telephone. The reporter is an employee at Inflatable Fun Factory, and Diekmann's juvenile son. I provided Diekmann with a case number.
