The driver closed the door and then immediately leaned back up against van. The driver was asked if he had anything to drink prior to the accident and he responded that he had been drinking Gin. The strong odor of alcoholic beverages could be smelled coming from the subject`s breath.</p> <p>Officers asked the subject if he would submit to some standardized field sobriety tests. The subject became upset and was non cooperative. SFST`s were unable to be preformed due to the behavior of the subject. The subject was placed in handcuffs and advised of his Miranda Rights. The subject stated he understood. The subject informed officers that he had some Marijuana inside of his sock. When officers looked into the van a rolled smoking device was observed sitting next to the ashtray near the center console. A plant like substance was observed inside the rolled smoking device.
