Officers were dispatched to a family dispute. The reporter stated she could hear screaming and arguing from 440.

Upon arrival, officers spoke to the reporter. The reporter stated that the homeowner and her friend (later found they have been in a sexual relationship in the past) have been getting into an argument all night. The reporter stated the argument went into the hallway and the two were throwing things. Officers were let into the building and went to the apartment where the argument was happening.

Officers stood at the door and heard two females verbally arguing. Officers heard one of the females state you need to leave (later identified as the homeowner). The friend stated no. Officers knocked on the door and informing the two they have been outside the door for some time. Officers informed them, they needed to stop fighting over who was going to answer the door, and just answer it. The friend answered the door, looking out the peephole. Officers heard the homeowner say open the door for the police, they have the right to come in. Officers then heard someone get smacked. Officers told the females to open the door the door or they would kick it in. Officers then heard stop. Officers heard a short time after, "Get Off of Me". Officers began to kick the door in attempt to force entry. Eventually, the homeowner opened the door. Both females were placed in handcuffs.

The homeowner was read Miranda and officers could see a red mark to the homeowner's chest. It appeared as if she had been smacked. The homeowner stated she understood her rights and informed officers that she had been criminal confined by her friend most of the day. The friend blocked the exit as the homeowner attempt to leave, even making excuses to do laundry. The homeowner stated at one point she was punched with a close fist by the friend, prior to officers` arrival. The homeowner had a visible cut to her lip (the visible bodily injuries happened during the criminal confinement). She stated she heard officers at the door and was attempting to answer it, when the friend blocked the door from her answering it and then placed her body in front of the door preventing/ obstructing officers forced entry into the home (preventing officers, while lawfully engaged, in the execution of the officers duties). The friend had been staying at the place for three days and the homeowner told her multiple times she needed to leave, but she refused to. The friend was also verbally barred per a case work in January of 2022 by another officer. During the interview the homeowner was visibly shaking stating we cannot arrest the friend because she would come back and hurt her. She later did not want to give her information for the victim notify, informing officers that the friend has gotten away with murder in the past, has a way into the building (unknown how). The homeowner stated they have been in a physical altercation in the past and she is afraid for her to sign or give her information to officers because she is afraid of the friend relating. She stated "she will kill me".

Officers attempted to read the friend Miranda, but she cried the whole time. Officers were unable to get any information from the friend, other than she was on the phone with a female member to calm down the homeowner. The odor of
