Officers were approaching the intersection of Twelfth and Franklin, when they observed an SUV disregard a flashing red light, heading south into the intersection of Twelfth and Franklin (heading south on twelfth, turning east on Franklin). Officers turned around and attempted to get behind the SUV. Officers observed the SUV activate their right turn signal and turn south on Tenth. Officers turned south on tenth and observed the vehicle heading west in the south alley (runs east and west). Officers turned west on Illinois and observed the SUV with its lights off traveling south in the parking lot behind Bud's Country Bar. Officers patted the driver down for weapons and located a loaded 9mm Taurus handgun in his left jacket pocket (one in chamber, five bullets in the magazine). Officers took the firearm off his person. The odor of alcohol was present, both on his breath and on his clothing. Another officer arrived on scene and patted the passenger down for weapons. He had no weapons. Officers initially released the passenger from the traffic stop, and he waited behind the bar for officers to complete their investigation. The passenger was later given a citation for marijuana (located in the passenger side door), which was later located in the vehicle after officers gained consent from the driver to search the vehicle. The passenger, post Miranda admitted to the green leafy substance the swisher sweet packet was his.</p> <p>Officers asked the driver if he would take field sobriety tests and a portable breathalyzer. The driver passed all tests given by officers. Officers read the driver Pirtle and Miranda; he stated he understood his rights. The driver gave officers consent to search his vehicle. The driver informed officers they would locate marijuana in the vehicle. Officers later located a green leafy substance in an open compartment under the radio and later a digital scale in a backpack behind the passenger seat. The 3.1 grams located under the radio and the 2.5 grams in the passenger door, later tested positive for marijuana using NARK II test Kit 05.
