Upon approaching the vehicle, we came into contact with the driver and front seat passenger (offender). We requested the occupant's identification. I entering the offender's name and date of birth into the NCIC database, which produced a return indicating he had an active outside agency warrant for his arrest. We confirmed that the warrant was active and the agency wanted the offender extradited.

The offender was searched incident to arrest and a plastic baggie containing green leafy substance was located in the offender's left sweatpants pocket. The substance was placed on a triple beam scale which produced a field weight of 5.3 grams. The substance was field tested using a Duquenois-Levine Reagent which produced a positive result for THC. The green leafy substance was placed into an evidence bag, labeled, and deposited into evidence.

The offender was provided a citation for possession of marijuana and was transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center via the Evansville Police Department transport wagon where he was booked on his outside agency warrant. The driver was release on scene with a written warning.
