Reported: 12/20/2022.</p> <p>While I was on a routine patrol on the above date and time, going westbound on Covert Ave passing the intersection with S Frederick St the above, Brown/Red color Chrysler 200 passed me going east bound. I observed thru my driver side, side mirror, that the above vehicle didn't have a plate light and plate was not illuminated, and was not readable. I proceeded to make a U-turn and initiated a traffic stop.</p> <p>During the stop, I approached the vehicle on the passenger side, and when I made contact with the driver I smelled strong odor of marijuana coming out from the vehicle. I asked the driver if she had any weed in the vehicle, and she stated that just a roach. When the assisting officer arrived at the scene, I proceeded to get the driver out of the vehicle. While the driver was walking towards my patrol vehicle she admitted that she had marijuana in the vehicle, inside her backpack.</p> <p>Next, I proceeded to search the vehicle and found 3 brown color paper rolled blunt ends with burned/ green leafy substance in them, which had strong odor of marijuana emitting from them. A Ziplock bag with green leafy substance in it, out of the black color backpack, laying on the front passenger seat. I was able to immediately identify the green leafy substance as marijuana, because of my officer training and experience. I also found a white color vape pen with a clear glass cartridge" inside it had gold color thick oil," attach to it out of the center console armrest storage area.</p> <p>While I was searching the car, I asked the assisting officer to read Miranda warning to the driver.</p> <p>Once I was finished with my search, I grabbed all the narcotics and paraphernalia that I found and showed it to the driver. I also asked the driver if she understood the Miranda warning and she stated yes. I asked the driver if all the found narcotics and paraphernalia belong to her, and she stated yes, and claimed ownership. The driver also stated that the vape pen with the cartridge that had the gold color thick oil in it would test positive for THC.</p> <p>The driver was cited and was released at the scene.</p> <p>Later at the WSO I used Nark 2, 05 Duquenois-levine reagent kit to test the green leafy substance in the Ziplock bag and the gold color thick oil and they both tested positive for THC. The green leafy substance had total field weight of 5 grams. I was not able to weigh the gold color thick oil out of the cartridge, due to it being stuck on the inner cartridge walls. All the evidence was dropped in the WSO JTF Narc Drop Box.</p>	AGHASARYAN,
