Once the above vehicle passed me going eastbound on Pollack Ave, I observed that the above vehicle did not have any plate lights on, and the plate was not illuminated. I proceeded to initiate a traffic stop.</p> <p>When I made contact with the driver from the passenger side of the vehicle, I smelled strong odor of marijuana coming out of it. I asked the driver if she had smoked marijuana earlier, because I could smell the strong odor. The driver admitted having a blunt earlier.</p> <p>Once the assisting officer arrived at the scene, I got the driver out of the vehicle and proceeded to search it. During the search I found 5 empty, opened, vacuumed sealable baggies from the front driver`s area, with CA warning tag on them, with Government warning in the back, stating that the baggies contains cannabis, scheduled 1 controlled substance. Baggies also had green leafy residue in them. I also found 5 silver color, round containers. Four of them had green leafy residue in them, but the 5th one which was out of the driver`s small bag back, had green leafy substance in it, and two burned cigar/blunt ends. Later in my patrol vehicle I used Narc 2, narcotics test kit to test the green leafy substance, and it tested positive for THC. Later, I weighed the green leafy substance at the EPD headquarters, and it had total field weight of 2.4 grams.</p> <p>Driver was cited and released at the scene.</p>		AGHASARYAN,

I was fully dressed in an Evansville Police Department uniform. I was dispatched to 3400 E Division Street (University of Evansville (UE) Baseball Field) regarding a standby. Bob Dale with UE advised that there is a two-story concrete building at the baseball field. He advised he was with maintenance and that someone was taking up residence inside of the building. He advised that he and maintenance wanted to clear it out.</p> <p>Upon arriving, I met with Bob and the maintenance team. They advised that UE owns the property and they had found that someone had been inside of the property. They further advised that there were candles lit and a substantial amount of personal property strewn inside. They wanted to clear out the building of any vagrants so they could sell the building and land to some interested and prospective buyers. Further, they said that they noticed a lock not belonging to the University had been placed on the garage door, preventing University staff from entering. They said the lock was cut off and the University had put their own lock on it. As I examined the new lock, I noticed that it had cut marks on it. The UE maintenance crew located a set of bolt cutters in the grass that had been broken, likely used on the lock. On the north end of the building, I observed some open windows with furniture stacked up just underneath it (as if someone used the furniture to climb up to the windows in order to gain access).</p> <p>Officer Afifi arrived to assist at this point. The UE maintenance staff opened the door and allowed us inside. I observed a staircase leading to the second floor as I entered. I announced our presence as "Evansville Police" and demanded that if anyone was inside that they let us know. I heard two voices say they were "here." I ordered them to show me their hands and had them walk down the stairs. Officer Afifi and I detained them using handcuffs. The subjects were identified as Kyle Lannert and Ryan Klauss.</p> <p>Officer Afifi remained with Ryan and Kyle while I cleared the upstairs. The upstairs was dark and I noticed a lot of personal property within the room. I noticed a lit candle on the floor next to an air mattress. As I was clearing the room, I observed a clear plastic baggie containing a white crystalline substance all contained within a clear plastic container. With it, I also noticed a baggie with a brown substance. Based on my training and experience, I believed the white crystalline substance was methamphetamine. I was unsure what the brown substance was at the time, but I seized the case containing it and the white crystalline substance for evidence. Additionally, I observed a purple and green glass smoking device containing residue. Officer Afifi took Ryan outside of the building while I took Kyle outside of the building. I noticed Kyle was wearing a medical boot on his right foot. I read Kyle the Miranda Warning, to which he advised he understood. I asked Kyle how long he had been staying inside of the building. Kyle advised that he and his romantic partner, Ryan, had been kicked out of their home and had been staying in the building for approximately a week. Kyle said during this time, no one else had been up there (although he would later change his story and go back and forth on if anyone else had been there). I asked him if all of the property in the room belonged to him. He advised it did, except for the items on top of the television which he found. I advised him that it appeared to be meth, and he then advised that he found it along with the smoking device. He would later say that they were the only ones in the building, but did not admit to it being his.

Since both subjects had entered the building with no permission and having no contractual obligation to the property, I had probable cause to arrest both of them for trespassing. I asked Officer Afifi if he could search Kyle, this time searching his boot. As soon as I mentioned to Officer Afifi that we needed to search his boot, Kyle openly admitted without being questioned that he had something inside of the boot. I asked him what it was, and he advised it was meth. Officer Afifi located a small plastic baggie containing a white crystalline substance in Kyle`s boot. Based on my training and experience, coupled with Kyle`s open admission, I believed the substance to be methamphetamine.

Jason Cullum, Director of UE Public Safety Office (and former EPD Sergeant), arrived on scene. He advised that he had been to the building on Wednesday, knowing that someone had been staying inside of the building without permission. He said that he was familiar with what personal property had been inside, to include several stolen credit cards from different people. He said that Officer Hackworth had been out there to collect them that day. He said that no one was inside of the building when he was there Wednesday. I had Jason come with me upstairs to show me what personal property was and was not present on Wednesday. Jason advised that the glass smoking device and the container containing the powder/crystalline substances located on the television was not present on Wednesday. Having heard that no one had been upstairs with Kyle and Ryan, coupled with the fact that Kyle said they found it a week prior, led me to develop probable cause to believe that both Kyle and Ryan were in possession of the methamphetamine and the paraphernalia I found upstairs.

Both Kyle and Ryan were arrested and transported to the Vanderburgh County Jail. At the Vanderburgh County Jail, I tested the two baggies with the white crystalline substance (the one found in Kyle`s boot and the one found upstairs in the clear case). Both tested positive for methamphetamine using NARK II test kit #15. I then tested the baggie with the brown substance. The brown substance appeared to be mixed with a crystalline substance when looking closely at it. The substance tested positive for methamphetamine using NARK II test kit #15. The field weight of the brown substance/methamphetamine and the methamphetamine found within the clear case came to 1.0 grams. The methamphetamine found in Kyle`s boot came to 1.5 grams. I used a zeroed triple balance beam scale to weigh the narcotics. I then properly bagged, sealed, labeled, and placed the three baggies of methamphetamine and the drug paraphernalia in the narcotics evidence locker at the Vanderburgh County Jail.
