aware he delivers often in many different areas of the state for DoorDash but primarily Indianapolis, Ft. Wayne and Hobart.

The victim believes the male sex offender used her Identification to work as an independent contractor working for DoorDash including while he was temporarily in Evansville. The victim states she absolutely has not done \$26,000 worth of deliveries for DoorDash and does not intend to pay taxes on any income from DoorDash that is reported to the IRS or Indiana Department of Revenue.

The victim states she reported the issue to DoorDash but was not given any appropriate direction or assistance by DoorDash. The victim says she has spoke with multiple people at DoorDash and was told the identity deception was under investigation and that her account was suspended.

A traffic stop on 6/01/22 in Vanderburgh County in RMS reports the offender stated he was visiting family in Evansville and delivering for DoorDash.

EPD FCU has taken a report but there has been little preliminary investigation. An attempt was made to call the offender but there was no answer. The victim believes the identity deception occurred in Evansville, Ft. Wayne and Indianapolis.

The victim was advised to go the IRS on Eagle Crest in person with this report and to also report the issue to the Indiana Dept of Revenue. The victim was advised to go continue going through the likely tedious process of reporting to DoorDash and to follow up with EPD FCU if she has further issues. The victim understands she must continue to follow up with this issue to resolve her tax liabilities.

The victim is checking her credit report and will follow up with EPD FCU. EPD FCU will attempt to forward this report to Allen County, Indiana concerning any possible sex registry violations.
