He said there was also a bag full of Fairchild's underwear and clothing packed up and left in the hallway where it hadn't been previously. I spoke with the listed suspect at her house. She admitted to having the lamp, but said Fulks had given it to her. The suspect showed me extensive Facebook Messenger messages (and noted audio calls) between her and Fulks, the majority of which appeared to be from the afternoon/evening of 01/19/2023 and after. In one of the messages, Fulks offered to exchange the lamp for a "bj." In another message, Fulks is venting to the suspect about how he found Fairchild in bed with another man in his house. The suspect explained to me that Fulks had walked in and found Fairchild in bed with "a black man," which apparently prompted their most recent relationship issues. The suspect said Fulks wanted to buy a security camera for her to put in her window so he could spy on Fairchild from the suspect's house. There were messages where links to security cameras were exchanged. The suspect said after Fairchild left the house, Fulks packed up all of Fairchild's things in trashbags and brought a lot of it over to her house. The suspect said she went over to Fulks' house and took the lamp with his permission before he walked her and the lamp back across the street to her house. The suspect said her hairdresser and 14 y/o daughter were at her house and witnessed this
