	<p>black females come into his store with shoe bags from another store, Windsor, and leave all points of entry, with four pair of stolen shoes from the Shoe Dept. (total value was over \$200).</p>		
	<p>Haywood saw the females put boxes of shoes from his store, the Shoe Department, into the Windsor bags. He followed the girls out of the Mall and into the parking lot. He said he grabbed the bags to retrieve the shoes. Haywood recorded the incident on his cellphone. He showed it to me and I watched it one time. I could clearly see the IO Juvenile (because of her height, 5-10, and wearing a black tee shirt and black pants) walking away from him.</p>		
	<p>Haygood told me that his store policy allows him to follow suspects out of the store and into the parking lot (while recording the incident and license plates of cars), but does not permit him to detain suspects or put his hands on them. He told me that he could only file theft charges if he retrieved the stolen items. He said that he grabbed at their "Windsor" bags, in an attempt to retrieve the shoes, but the girls pulled away from him (This is on his cell phone video).</p>		
	<p>As I was talking to him, Ashley Nichols, the mother of IO Juvenile called Mall Security and said she wanted Haygood fired for racially profiling her daughter and grabbing her. Ashley refused to make a report with security over the phone and said she was coming to the Mall.</p>		
	<p>I met with the reporter, Ashley Nichols, IO (Shane Moore) and the Juvenile IO who said "We got manhandled and racially profiled." (There was a third girl with them who I did not identify). Ashley said that the girls who the only ones "of color" in the store and they were singled out and harassed.</p>		
	<p>I interviewed the Juvenile IO who told me that she came into the store with her friends and when she left, Haygood followed her and grabbed her bag. She said, "Why are you grabbing my bag? I didn't do nothing!" The juvenile said that Haygood let go of her bag and "manhandled" Moore. The Juvenile said she threatened Moore that she was going to get her mom since he thought she was stealing and he replied, "Go ahead, I'll be waiting" as he followed them recording with his cell phone.</p>		
	<p>Next, I interviewed Shane Moore, who gave me a false name of Shanae Richard (because she was banned from Eastland Mall for attempted theft in October of 2022). She told me that Haygood stopped Jasmine inside the store and accused her of stealing and grabbed her bag. Moore said that he let go of her and came after her. She said she was carrying two bags and he grabbed one of them and started shaking her bag until it tore and he followed them all the way to the parking lot and recorded them. Moore never said that Haywood "grabbed" any part of her body, but only her bags.</p>		
	<p>As they were leaving, I asked once again, if Haygood grabbed them or just the bags. Moore and the Juvenile said Haywood "grabbed" them. I mentioned that it would be captured on the Mall's security cameras and I gave Ashley the case number of the Incident Report.</p>
