The private tow yard of Tri-State Towing was advised this is not to be considered a stolen vehicle but rather a vehicle towed during a custodial felony arrest with an unlicensed operator. It is alleged that this was a privately rented out vehicle in Florida through one or more different parties.</p> <p>The vehicle was not in NCIC at the time of the tow. This report is for the hit confirmation.
