	The vehicle was towed on 02-03-23 during the arrest of three (3) Chilean Crime ring offenders that had traveled from Florida to Evansville. The vehicle was towed to Tri-State Towing on 02-03-23 where it has been safely stored at the private tow yard. The offenders operating the vehicle had the keys to the vehicle and after investigation EPD is aware of their travels from Florida to Evansville. The offenders are members of the crime group named by the FBI of "South American Theft Group".	
	Today was the first time EPD has been contacted about the Yukon with considerable value. Detectives have made attempts to get in touch with the vehicle's owner with no prior success. EPD Detectives would like to speak with the alleged victim, regarding his involvement. The request to speak to the victim and ask for cooperation has been relayed to Osceola County Sheriff's Office.	
	The Indiana Statue for Auto Theft was not met in the state of Indiana. The private tow yard of Tri-State Towing was advised this is not to be considered a stolen vehicle but rather a vehicle towed during a custodial felony arrest with an unlicensed operator. It is alleged that this was a privately rented out vehicle in Florida through one or more different parties.
