A plastic bag containing a small amount of plant like subjstance was located in the Harris's right pocket. The subtance in the bag later field tested positive for marijuana with a Duquenois-Levine Reagent test kit 05 and weighed less than 1 gm. Harris was advised of his Miranda Rights and he stated he understood. Harris was asked if he smoked marijuana and he said that he did. He said that the blunt in his pocket was from smoking marijuana today, and that the plastic bag is what he had left of his marijuana.

The vehicle was searched and a small bag containing a plant like substance, along with an orange pill with the engraving "54 375" identified as Buprenorphine Hydrochloride and Naloxone Hydrochloride was located in a purse by the front passenger's seat. The purse was identified as belonging to the front passenger, identified as Ashley Kratzer. Kratzer stated that the pill and marijuana belonged to her

The plant like substance field tested positive for marijuana with a Duquenois-Levine Reagent test kit 05 and weighed 2.4gm. The orange pill was identified as a schedule 3 narcotic drug and Kratzer did not have a valid prescription.

Officer Brasher began searching the vehicle and located a tied zip lock bag of a green leafy substance in the glovebox of the vehicle. The suspect stated he rented the vehicle and it was his name on the rental agreement. The substance was weighed and tested once at the VCCC. The substance was positive for marijuana using test kit 05 Duquenois-levine reagent marijuana.

Officer Brasher also located an empty bottle wine behind the suspect's seat.

The suspect passed all SFST's and did not wish to take a chemical breath test at the jail.

The suspect was charged with controlled substance-possession - marijuana/hash oil/hashish and a traffic offense of open container violation.
