Officers received a returned that she was suspended infraction. Officers called for another officer and went back to the vehicle, asking the driver to step out. Officers asked if she would take field sobriety tests, and she agreed.</p> <p>The driver failed the horizontal gaze nystagmus test, past the walk and turn, and failed the one legged stand. Officers informed her that they were going to tow her vehicle because of her driver status. Officers began the inventory of the vehicle, and located open/half drank alcohol in the front passenger seat. Officers placed the driver in handcuffs and asked her if she would do a portable Breathalyzer. The female blew a .165 and was read implied consent, which she stated she understood. The female later consent to a certified chemical test, and failed it blowing a .143.
