Numerous panhandler/homeless subjects rejected the fraud suspects attempts because they understand the felony check cashing scam from experience and education.

A traffic stop was made at Vann/Washington on the white Mazda CX-5. Prior to the stop the CX-5 failed to signal at Washington / Governor and then made an improper turn at Cover Ave. / Vann Ave.

During the traffic stop a panhandler/homeless male in the backseat advised the front seat suspects had just met him and picked him up. The male advised after he got into the vehicle, the front seat suspects took his identification and told him he would make quick money.

Clothing believed to be part of the scam was in the backseat. The scam involves dressing the homeless into new clothing and or construction clothing and sending the panhandler/homeless subject into a Tri-State bank. The offenders park down the street and do not go into the bank. The homeless/panhandler then commits felony fraud with a a stolen or fraudulent check as instructed. If the bank fails to understand that the check is fraudulent the check is cashed for currency. The fraud offenders keep the money and leave the Tri-State unidentified and not on camera.

During the traffic stop the vehicle had an extremely strong odor of raw and burnt marijuana coming from it. A small amount of a green leafy substance that field tested positive for THC was located on the operator's door and in the console. The vehicle operator from Atlanta was taken to EPD HQ and then VCCC for possession of marijuana. The passenger (suspect #2) and homeless male (suspect #3) were released.

The rental vehicle was towed to Tri-State Towing.

The fraud investigation is ongoing. Linked with Narcotics case 23-05405.
