The offender kept trying to push himself off of the ground and would not stop trying to push his hands underneath of him. Later, after a breath struggle, we were able to overcome the offender's force and placed him in handcuffs without further incident and all force was ceased. Two officers sustained minor injuries/cuts from the struggle. Later, the offender admitted
