Officers ran the driver through both Indiana and Illinois DMV, along with RMS. Officers received a return that the driver had a warrant out of Vanderburgh County. Officers confirmed the warrant with EPD records and returned back to the truck.

Once at the truck, officers had the driver step out of the vehicle. Officers observed the driver stagger from the vehicle. The driver was patted down for weapons and then asked if he would consent to Field Sobriety Tests (SFSTs). While leaning against the vehicle for support, the driver still with slurred speech denied SFSTs. Officers placed the driver in handcuffs. The driver began to raise his voice and become verbally aggressive, stating he did not understand why he was going to jail. Officers explained he had an active warrant. The driver continued to raise his voice and was asked again to lower his voice. He did for a brief time, later raising it again. Officers walked him back to their patrol vehicle and searched the driver incident to arrest.

During the search, officers located a green plastic tube on the driver's person. Inside the tube were two brown rolled papers with a green leafy substance. The odor of marijuana was present. The 2 grams of brown paper and green leafy substance later tested positive for THC using NARK II test kit 05. Officers read the driver Miranda and began to ask him questions about where he was coming from and how much he had to drink or what else he ingested (odor of alcohol was present on the driver's breath). The driver avoided the questions about what he ingested. The driver did inform officers he was in town for graduation of a family member and that his car was broke down in another city.
