The offender grabbed the victim around the throat and squeezed to the point that the victim could no longer breath. The children were in the same room as this was happening. While choking the victim the offender was telling her that he was going to kill her.</p> <p>The victim had visible marks on the front and back of her neck. Pictures were taken of the injuries and the victim was provided a case number.</p> <p>The offender was located. The offender was advised of his Miranda Rights and stated he understood. The offender claimed that there was a verbal argument between him and his girlfriend. He was adamant that nothing physical occurred.
