Officers could tell the pole had been hit previously by an unknown vehicle (ran off road right) before the blue passenger vehicle ran over the pole. Officers and a good samaritan were able to get the pole out from under the vehicle. The good samaritan was also able to get the pole out of the roadway. Officers did not see any visible damage to the blue passenger vehicle nor did the pole appear to have damage from the blue passenger vehicle. At this time, it is unknown what vehicle struck the pole causing it to fall, or what time the incident occurred. Officers were dispatched to a medical assist.
