The vehicle never came to a complete stop. Officers turned their vehicle around and got behind the vehicle. Officers activated their emergency lights and conducted a traffic stop near the intersection of First and Columbia.</p> <p>Officers approached the driver side of the vehicle. The odor of raw marijuana and perfume was present when speaking with the driver. Officers asked the driver if she knew why she was being pulled over. She stated she thought it was because she pulled out in front of officers. Officers explained she did not come to a full stop at the stop sign. Officers collected the driver's information and walked to their marked police vehicle. The driver was still actively looking for her insurance (it was later found on her phone).</p> <p>Once back at their police vehicle, officers began running the driver's information through RMS and the Indiana BMV. Moments later another unit arrived on scene and officers explained to them, they smelled the odor of marijuana, but their was also a heavy odor of perfume. Officers walked back up to the vehicle and had the driver step out. The driver was patted down for weapons and walked back to the officer's vehicle. Officer asked and gained consent to search the vehicle from the driver. Officers then searched the vehicle.</p> <p>Officers later located multiple vape pens and cartridges containing THC. Officers located a glass pipe with burnt residue, and also brown papers with a green leafy substance inside. The 3.2 grams of brown paper and green leafy substance later tested positive for marijuana using NARK II test kit 05. All items were collected and the driver was told to return to her vehicle, but not to leave.</p> <p>Officers went back to their police vehicle and wrote the driver a citation (8220171329). Officers then went back up to the black passenger vehicle and gave/explained the citation to the driver.
