We confirmed via the local Records Management System (RMS), the driver had 5 active misdemeanor warrants out of Vanderburgh County. The driver was unable to provide insurance or registration for the vehicle. Upon entering the driver's name and date of birth into the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles database, I observed the driver's license status was suspended- infraction.

The driver was searched incident to arrest. Officers located a pill bottle, which did not bear the driver's name, in his pocket. The pill bottle contained Atomoxetine Hydrochloride and Desvenlafaxine Succinate which are both classified as legend drugs. The pill bottle also contained Suboxone, a schedule III controlled substance under the Controlled Substance Act (CSA).

The contents of the vehicle were inventoried prior to tow. Officer located a clear plastic baggie containing Gabapentin, a legend drug, and Pregabalin, a schedule V controlled substance under the CSA.

The driver was read his Miranda Rights which he stated he understood. The driver stated he did not know the license plate on the vehicle was stolen. The driver stated he had prescriptions for the pills, but did not have a prescription or pill bottle to provide.

The stolen license plate was seized as evidence. The above mentioned pills were placed in labelled evidence bags and deposited at EPD Headquarters. The vehicle was towed to 1501 N Evans Ave by Tri-State Towing. The driver was transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center where he was booked and processed for his warrants, possession of stolen property, possession of a schedule I, II, III, IV, or V controlled substance, and possession of a legend drug.
