Officers observed the victim's eyes were watering, his face was red, and he was wet from having just exited the shower. I photographed the victim's injury with my BodyWorn camera. The victim stated he arrived at the listed address after observing the reporter drive by his house. The victim stated he parked his motorcycle at the passenger window of the reporter's white Jeep. The victim stated the vehicle was being driven by the reporter's brother and the reporter was in the passenger seat. The victim stated the reporter rolled down her window and sprayed him in the face with mace.

The victim stated the reporter exited the vehicle and began to beat him with a baton. The victim stated he was able to take the mace and baton from the reporter and throw them in an unknown direction as he could not see very well due to the mace. The victim stated the offender got into the driver's seat of the vehicle and backed into his motorcycle as he stood next to it. The victim stated he picked up his motorcycle and began to flee southbound through an alley. The victim stated the reporter gave chase causing him to wreck his motorcycle into a ditch. The victim stated he picked up his motorcycle and fled to his home to attempt to gain relief from the mace. Officers observed the victim's motorcycle had sustained

Officers returned to the listed address where the reporter was placed in doublelocked handcuffs and read her Miranda Rights which she stated she understood. The reporter was asked to repeat her version of events which she declined. I asked the reporter if her brother had been present in her vehicle during the altercation which she denied.

I spoke to the witness and asked him what had occured at the listed address. The witness stated the reporter had been at a friend's home when the victim arrived. The witness stated the reporter called him to pick her up because she is scared of the victim. The witness stated he drove the reporter to the listed address where the victim arrived and pulled alongside the passenger side of the car. The witness stated the reporter sprayed the victim in the face with mace. The witness stated the reporter got out of the car and began to wrestle with the victim. The witness stated the victim took the mace and threw it into a yard to the north. The witness stated the reporter got into her car and backed into the victim's motorcycle. The witness stated the victim fled on his motorcycle southbound through the alley and the reporter gave chase. The witness stated the reporter did not strike the victim's motorcycle in the alley, but he believed the victim wrecked his motorcycle. I located a can of mace in a yard north of where the incident took place. I photographed the mace with my BodyWorn camera and it was disposed of.

The reporter was previously convicted of domestic battery in Vanderburgh County against the victim. The reporter was transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center via the Evansville Police Department transport wagon where she was booked and processed for the above listed charges.
