I located a small clear plastic baggie with white crystalline residue in the center console of the vehicle. I located a white crystalline substance lying under the front right passenger seat. Due to my training and experience, I recognized the white crystalline substance as methamphetamine. I collected the aforementioned items in evidence bags.
