I entered the male's name and date of birth into the National Crime Information Center database upon which I discovered he had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant out of Vanderburgh County as a well as an outstanding parole violation warrant out of Indianapolis.</p> <p>I searched the male's person incident to arrest. I located a small plastic baggie in the male's front right pocket which contained a green leafy substance. Due to my training and experience, I recognized the green leafy substance as marijuana. The male was transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center where he was booked and processed for his warrants and possession of marijuana.</p> <p>I weighed the green leafy substance on a triple beam scale which produced a field weight of 1.3 grams. I field tested the green leafy substance with a Duquenois-Levine Reagent test which yielded a positive result for THC.
