On the listed date, I, Officer Hastings, was traveling north bound in the left lane on Boeke Rd approaching Columbia St in my commissioned fully marked Evansville Police Department vehicle, when I observed a small passenger car south on Boeke Rd approaching me. I observed the vehicle quickly change lanes and continue past me. I turned around and was able to catch up to said vehicle as it turned east onto the on-ramp for the Lloyd Expy. I observed the vehicle strike the curb and swerve back onto the roadway. As the vehicle continued east bound on the Lloyd Expy, the vehicle was swerving from its lane into other lanes. I activated the emergency lights and siren on my patrol car and attempted to stop the vehicle at the Lloyd Expy and Stockwell Rd. The vehicle, a black 2013 Mazda 3(IN 226BIO '24 exp) continued traveling east bound, failing to yield and exited the Lloyd Expy toward Green River Rd. As the suspect vehicle approached Green River Rd, I observed several vehicles traveling south on Green River Rd and made sure my siren was activated. I observed the vehicles south on Green River Rd stop as the suspect slowed, but continued and went south on Green River Rd. The suspect vehicle continued and then turned east onto Tecumseh Ln. The vehicle was driving slowly, but was still weaving back and forth between the two lanes of travel. The suspect vehicle then turned south on Shamrock and then turned onto Fairmont Dr into the Fairmont Apartment complex. The suspect vehicle continued to the end of the parking lot and stopped. The driver, from here on know as the offender, exited the vehicle as I was yelling commands for him to stay at the vehicle. The offender turned and fled behind the apartment building. The offender continued as I was yelling for him to stop. The offender eventually lost his balance and fell to the ground. At that point, Officer Bell, McNeely and I took the offender into custody. Once the offender was detained, I realized the offender spoke very little English. Officer Rose was on scene and with the assistance of his wife, who speaks Spanish, she was able to explain to the offender what he was going to be charged with.

I transported the offender to the Vanderburgh Co Confinement Center where I conducted the Standard Field Sobriety tests on the offender. I used Google Translate app on my cell phone in order to give the instructions to the offender. The offender was tested and failed all tests given. The offender was then tested on a portable breath test instrument and showed breath alcohol level of .176% per 210liters of breath. I then escorted the offender into the intoxilyzer room. I continued to use Google Translate to read the Indiana Implied Consent to the offender. The offender stated he understood and would submit. I used Google Translate to instruct the offender on how to take the test and to blow when instructed. I explained this three different times and each sample given the offender did not blow long enough to give a sufficient sample. I reasonably believe the offender understood the instructions and was refusing to provide a valid sample. The offender was then housed on the listed charges.
