Reported: 09/22/2023.</p> <p>Officers were actively patrolling the area of E Franklin St and N Weinbach Ave in marked unit 1907 and in full uniform. Officers observed a white male riding a bicycle north bound approaching the above intersection without a visible front white light attached to the front of his bicycle. Officers initiated a traffic stop near the intersection of E Franklin St and N Weinbach Ave.</p> <p>The white male, later identified as Christopher Watts, emptied out his front left pocket when asked by on scene officers. While emptying his pockets Christopher stated something might be in there. Christopher had a green leafy substance wrapped in plastic. Through training and experience on scene officers believe the substance to be marijuana. During incident to arrest officers located a crystal like substance inside of the same container the marijuana was in.</p> <p>Christopher was read Miranda Warning before being questioned. Christopher admitted to purchasing marijuana earlier that night and placing it inside the same container officers located the crystal like substance in. The crystal like substance tested positive for methamphetamines with a field weight of 2.5 grams. The green leafy substance tested positive for marijuana and had a field weight of 1.8 grams. Christopher was transported to VCCC for booking.</p> <p>While Christopher was being transported in marked unit 1907 to VCCC, he stated to Ofc Christian that he would take his life away if he touched him.
