Substance-Possession On 10/18/2023, Officers were on routine patrol in a fully marked police vehicle Marijuana/hash driving in the area of Sweetser Ave and Elliott St. We observed a silver Lincoln Oil/hashish/ MKX driving eastbound. We entered the vehicle's license plate into the Indiana Bureau of Motor Vehicles database and observed the registered owner is designated as a habitual traffic violator for life. We initiated a traffic stop in the 1700 block of S Elliott St due to the registered owner's drivers status. On approach, Officers recognized the odor of marijuana emanating from the vehicle. The driver and sole occupant was detained in handcuffs while a probable cause search was conducted. I located a plastic baggie containing a green leafy substance in the center console. Due to my training and experience, I recognized the substance as marijuana. While standing in the street, the driver began to repeatedly yell. The driver was warned she was making an unreasonable amount of noise in a public place. The driver disregarded the warning and continued to yell. The driver was transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center where she was booked and processed for the listed charges. The plastic baggie containing the green leafy substance was weighed on a tripled beam scale producing a field weight of 6.8 grams. The green leafy substance was field tested with a Duquenois-Levine Reagent test producing a positive result for THC. The plastic baggie containing the green leafy substance was placed into a labelled evidence bag and deposited into the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center Dropbox.
