While answering Central Dispatch on the radio, Ward made statements he knew his license may show Suspended. Ward stated he was suspended approximately twenty years ago. Ward admitted to having changed/corrected the registration plates yet, stating "I was getting ready to do that Monday." Officers returned to the squad car to check Ward's driving status through the BMV which showed him as a Habitual Traffic Violator - Life on a Regular ID Card. Officers requested Tri-State Towing to respond. Officers later determined Ward has a previous conviction for Operating a Motor Vehicle after Forfeiture-Life on 07/14/2015.
