VI stated when the OF showed up he appeared heavily intoxicated and he demanded to see his daughter so she let him in.

The VI informed officers while he was in the home he began to argue with the VI in her bed room with their daughter on the floor watching television. IO1 is a juvenile under the age of sixteen that witnessed the domestic violence take place that evening. The VI's left ankle was swollen and she complained of pain. There were visible marks on the VI's neck were she informed officers the OF had grabbed her. There was a cut above the right side of her lip where the OF hit her with the cell phone.

Photos were taken of her injuries. The VI refused AMR due to not wanting expensive medical bills to pay for. The VI appeared to be in pain and she stated that she was afraid of the OF.
