Officers were advised a W/F and W/M were outside screaming at each other and stated it was the same female officers observed yelling on Harriet Street. Officers arrived and located Waller in the 1100blk of Mary near the Missouri Street intersection. Waller pointed to a family on their porch and stated they were causing issues all night. Officers on scene knew that particular family had just arrived minutes earlier to grieve their recent loss and have not been causing any issues. Waller was unsteady on her feet and had difficulty balancing. Waller continued to argue with officers. Officers took Waller into custody without incident.
