Reported: 12/27/2023.</p> <p>Officers were actively patrolling the area of Keck Ave and N Weinbach Ave when they observed a black passenger car, IN plate 642COZ, cross over the center lane without signaling. A traffic stop was initiated near the above intersection in marked patrol car 1907 and in full uniform.</p> <p>The operator/ IO1 informed officers he and the registered owner/ OF, Savannah Greulich, just got some food from Wendy's. Savannah confirmed they just picked up some food from Wendy's and were going back to IO1's house. On scene officers observed Savannah visibly shaking while holding her cell phone when she was sitting in her vehicle with the heat on. Officers asked both occupants to step out of the vehicle.</p> <p>A K9 officer arrived on scene and performed an open air sniff of the vehicle. The K9 alerted on Savannah's vehicle for narcotics. Officers located multiple "balls" of tin foil with burnt residue inside the vehicle. The burnt residue on the tin foil also matched the burnt residue on multiple rolled up bills of currency. Two lightly colored "rocks" were wrapped in foil that was next to a cut up straw. Through officers training and experience the burnt residue on the foil, the cut straw and the burnt residue on the currency was used to ingest narcotics.</p> <p>The two light colored rocks, burnt residue on the foil and burnt residue on the currency tested positive for fentanyl. The two lightly colored rocks had a field weight of .64 grams and the burnt residue in the foil had a field weight of 1.64 grams. Savannah was transported to VCCC for booking. IO1 was released from the scene.</p> <p>While officers were processing Savannah's property at VCCC they located more narcotics. Prior to locating the narcotics Savannah was asked on scene and before the booking process began if she had any other narcotics in her possession and she stated she did not. Officers located three peach colored pills with "54 375" marks inside of Savannah's Coach wallet. According to Drugs.com, the three pills are "Buprenorphine Hydrochloride" which is a scheduled three controlled substance. While Savannah was being booked, VCCC confinement officers located a white piece of paper containing a crystal like substance.
