Upon arrival, officers located the vehicle and discovered that the plate on the vehicle did not match the description. Officers then observed a male exiting the car and walking toward the 1408 E Illinois Street house. Officers made contact with the male suspect, who stated he was headed into his sister's house.

Officers approached the house to speak with the reporter and the male suspect. The reporter stated the male suspect was her brother, and she informed officers that he just headed out the house's back door. Officer Huff informed Officer Hastings that the male exited the back door. Officer Hastings went to the back of the house and did not find the male suspect. Officer Hastings then observed the male attempting to leave out the back door and ordered the suspect to stop. The suspect then returned inside the house and locked the door behind him.

Officer Hastings informed Officer Huff that the male had returned inside the house. Officer Huff then made contact with the suspect at the front door and ordered him to come outside. The suspect then ran out the front door of the house, jumped off the porch, and led Officer Huff to use necessary force to place the suspect in custody. Officer Huff then read the suspect his Miranda Rights.

Upon investigation, the vehicle the suspect was exiting was discovered to be stolen, and the plate on the car was found to be stolen from a different vehicle located at 1400 E Columbia Street. Officers also discovered that the suspect had warrants in the state of Kentucky.

Crime Scene was called out to the scene for the stolen vehicle. Officers arrested the suspect and transported him to VCCC.

As we pulled by the vehicle, I instructed Officer Huff to run the license plate through the BMV. The plate returned to the reporter's business and was to be on a silver Chrysler Sebring. Moments later, Officer Huff was able to make contact with the resident at 1408 E Illinois and she stated the male had fled out the back. I didn't observe this since I was at the back of the residence. Officer Huff questioned the female again and at that moment, I observed the involved attempting to flee out the rear of the residence. I then heard Officer Huff yelling commands for someone to stop and as I came around the front of the residence, I observed Officer Huff had the involved on the ground taking him into custody.
