The window is a second story window on the west side of the house. A passerby, standing on the northeast corner of the intersection, turns to look at the window when she leans out of it. The passerby turns and gives her his full attention. A few moments later you can see her pulled back into the house in an aggressive/insolent manner. The video footage was saved and should be collected by crime scene detectives in the following days.</p> <p>I pulled Jessica to the side and spoke with her while officers were speaking with Ryan and Melissa. I told her there is a possibility that camera footage was obtained of the incident. Jessica changed her story and admitted to hanging out the window, but stated Terry pulled her back in so she would not fall. Officer Hardin, several minutes later, told me what he saw after watching the camera footage (listed above). He also told me Ryan and Melissa were adamant that she was yelling for help and she stated he was trying to kill her. The decision was made to arrest Terry on domestic battery and confinement charges. I told Jessica what Terry was being arrested for. I told her she was confined to the room on the second story. She had to yell, for help, out of a second story window instead of going downstairs and outside to ask for help. I told Jessica that multiple witnesses heard her ask for help and state that Terry was going to kill her.
