I, Officer Frazier, was dispatched to a Domestic Violence in Progess at the listed address (Deluxe Inn). Dispatch stated across from room 124 someone was being assaulted. The reporting party was refusing to give description or answer any questions.

I arrived and made contact with the victim, identified as Curtis Harville. There was blood on his front door and on the concrete in front of the door. Curtis walked out of the front door with blood all over his face. I asked Curtis what happened. He stated the offenders, later identified as Eldred Williams and Bobbie Thomas, came over to his room. Bobbie asked Curtis, the day prior, to keep multiple bags of clothes in his room (for her) until she got paid and could get a room herself. He agreed to store her cloths for her. Curtis told Bobbie he would bring her cloths outside to her, but did not want them (Bobbie and Eldred) near his room. Curtis opened the door, an arguement insued, and both offenders entered his room. I asked Curtis if they had permission to enter is room and he said they did not. Eldred picked up a chair inside the room and struck Curtis in the face with it. Eldred and Bobbie hit Curtis multiple times with closed fists. He grabbed a knife in his room and removed it from his sheath. Bobbie and Eldred saw the knife and left the room.

I spoke with Matthew Hargett. He is a taxi driver that gave Bobbie and Eldred a ride to Curtis' room at the Deluxe Inn. Bobbie and Eldred exited his vehicle and he saw them having a conversation with Curtis at the front door of his room. He turned his vehicle around and when he looked back they were entering the room. I asked him if he saw how Bobbie and Eldred made entry into the room (invitation or other). He stated he did not see how they entered the room.

Eldred and Bobbie were both detained. Eldred was read his Miranda Warning and stated he understood. Eldred stated they were invited to Curtis' room to pick up Bobbie's property. They entered the room and Curtis closed the door behind them. He was agitated they were over there and pulled out a knife. Eldred picked up the chair, in self defense, and they were able to exit the room. Bobbie, after being read her Miranda Warning, gave a similar story.

Curtis was transported, by AMR, to St Vincent hospital. Curtis had a laceration above his left eye and bruising around his left eye. The EMT's believed he might need stitches and, at the time of this affidavit, it was unknown if he had any internal head injuries. He had an abrasion on his chest and a ripped shirt. He had cuts and fresh bruising on both legs. His injuries were documented by a crime scene detective.

Bobbie and Eldred were transported to VCCC and booked on the listed charges.
