I advised the driver of the reason I had stopped his vehicle. The driver was slurring his words for the duration of the stop. I requested the driver's license, insurance, and registration. The driver took an extended period of time searching before providing his identification card.</p> <p>I approached the driver's side of the vehicle. I immediately recognized the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the driver's breath. I asked the driver if he had been drinking which he confirmed. The driver consented to a search of his vehicle. The driver submitted to a series of field sobriety tests which he failed. The driver submitted to a portable breathalyzer test of which he registered a reading of 0.096. The driver was placed into doublelocked handcuffs and transported to the Vanderburgh County Confinement Center. The vehicle was towed to 1501 N Evans Ave.</p> <p>The driver was read Indiana Implied Consent and submitted to a chemical test upon which he registered a reading of 0.088 grams of alcohol per 210 liters of breath.
