I then informed the offender that I was going to give her a field sobriety test and she could go home if she passed. The offender then became confrontational and aggravated while we waited for another officer to arrive on scene. Both officers that arrived on scene stated that they smelled the odor of slcohol on her breath. I then began to attempt to administer the Standardized Field Sobriety Tests for the offender. She was confrontational for the duration and did not follow officers commands. I asked the offender if she had any problems with her eyes. She stated that she did and stated that "she could not see, but she could see that I was a bitch".
