Officers were dispatched to 1012 S Boeke Rd in reference to a burglary in progress at Cool Breeze Vapor. The reporter, Kristina Crook, advised dispatch she was stopped at the light at Washington Ave/Boeke Rd when she saw two subjects around the entrance of the business and then saw glass breaking. Crook could not provide any further information.

On scene, officers observed forced entry on the front glass door to the business and could see several display cases with merchandise inside appeared to be broken. Contact was made with Geren who is a property manager for the Ross Center, the complex where Cool Breeze Vapor is located. Geren advised she never got a call from the alarm company, but would be enroute to the scene. While awaiting Geren's arrival a county K9 unit arrived on scene and began to canvas the area, to no avail. Geren arrived on scene allowing officers to safely clear the business by entering a back door to avoid the broken and fallen glass on the front door. No one was located inside the business. Geren began to review security footage from multiple cameras at the business and the property owner, Brown, arrived on scene. The camera footage showed what appeared to be two younger male's inside the business at 0528 taking merchandise from the broken display cases. No cameras from the business showed the males egress. Other officers went to the Marathon Gas Station across the street to ask to review video footage. Those officers advised the males arrived from the south on Boeke Rd and egressed to the south on Boeke Rd. The county K9 unit again canvassed the area to the south of the business, but again to no avail. Multiple residences in the area had video cameras affixed and were annotated for potential follow up.

Crime scene was called and arrived to process the scene. A total of three glass display cases had the top glass broken out, Brown estimated the value of each display case to be \$800. Brown estimated the cost of the damaged glass door to be \$2,000. Brown and Geren could not give an accurate count or description of the merchandise that was taken from the business at the time of this report. However, based on what they knew to be in the cases prior to the burglary and the fact that even the product not taken from the cases must be damaged out due to exposure to broken glass, they estimate the total loss in merchandise to be \$9,500.

The detectives office was made aware of the run and Brown was provided with a case number. Brown was advised to call back with a better account of the stolen and damaged merchandise when possible.
