Katie just moved to Evansville from California. She gets a monthly deposit on a Direct Express Card from Social Security. She stated because of the transition between states she only received a partial SSI payment. Her normal payment would be processed on to her card on the first of every month. She received her first payment, in Indiana, on July 9th.

Katie was admitted to Deaconess Midtown on July 8th (one day prior to the deposit). Susan is in possession of her Direct Express Card and knows the PIN for it. On July 9th a deposit of \$628 was processed in Katie's account. When the account was checked on 07/27/24 there was only \$0.38 in the account. Multiple transactions have been made using Katie's card.

Susan was asked about the \$628. She claims when she calls the number associated with the card it tells her that deposit is pending. Susan was told that Katie can see the deposit was processed and that other transactions have been made with her card. Susan's repeated response is the deposit is pending.
