When they got out of the water around 0915 hours the listed offender was in his pick up truck waiting for them. He started yelling at them for fishing and stating they need to stop and stay out of here. He said these are his fish. Victim 2 began recording on his phone during the argument. The offender never left his vehicle. During the incident the victim`s stated the offender said it would be a shame if something happened to their lines and also if something happened to the brake lines of their truck. Only part of the incident is recorded. After the offender drove off another male who was walking on the walkway above the boat ramp began yelling at the victims. He was making racial comments but it is unknown who he is or if he was also angry about the fishing.</p> <p>The offenders Plate number was able to be seen on the video. I ran the plate and confirmed the registered owner was the subject in the video. The victim`s stated they have had in increase of incidents like this due to people being angry about them being allowed to fish here commercially. they stated they have already talked with DNR about this and they have all the proper permits/licenses. I gave the victim`s a case number and advised them to call 911 if they have any further incidents.</p> <p>After the victim`s had left the offender pulled back up to speak with me. He started by asking what could be done to keep these commercial fisherman off the river. I informed him that I was taking a report due to the earlier incident. He admitted to confronting the victim`s but stated he never made any threats. He stated that what he had said was "It`d be a shame if your lines(for their fishing nets) got caught in my anchor." He said he is not happy that they`re allowed to fish here and does not believe they are following the guidelines placed on them. He was advised if that`s the case he needs to make that report to the proper departments and not take matters into his own hands.
