Elaman said he attempted to make contact with Hall multiple times by knocking on windows around the house. Elaman said at one point a male he did not know the name of, Brittain, came out of the residence and battered him. Elaman initially referred to Brittain as Hall`s boyfriend, but later told officers that he was Hall`s cousin.</p> <p>Hall told officers that she was in a relationship with Elaman, but they had not been together in several months. Hall said she was now in a form of intimate relationship with Brittain. Hall and Brittain said Elaman had been attempting to communicate with Hall via cell phone all night, calling many times as well as sending text messages. Both Hall and Brittain said Elaman showed up at the residence around 0000 hours, then began knocking on the door and windows around the residence. Hall said Elaman knew that the door to the residence could be pried open with a screw driver. Hall told officers that Elaman was heard trying to open the door and once the door was open Hall and Brittain confronted Elaman. Hall said she took the screw driver from Elaman and Brittain said he punched Elaman as he was not welcome at the residence.</p> <p>There was a Ring camera inside a window of the address that was able to show officers portions of the incident. Elaman was fist seen at the residence at 2344 hours, walking away. Elaman is seen again walking away at 0041. A short time later a clattering noise can be heard and Brittain appears on the camera, after he said he exited the residence following Elaman getting the door open and getting punched by Brittain. Brittain was then seen walking away from the residence. When asked, Brittain told officers he was ensuring Elaman was leaving the property.
